




If you are a dad with a child aged between 3 years and 6 years and are interested in attending this free course then this is for you.

Dads Cycle from Lewisham to Paris in 24 hours

10 Dads will be leaving from Catford Town Hall on Friday 22nd July at 3.30pm to cycle to Antony (Paris) to raise awareness of the importance of Dads in children's lives. The trip involves cycling the 64 miles to Newhaven from Lewisham then getting the night ferry to Dieppe and then cycling the 120 miles down to Paris.

The dads are part of a Cycling Group in Lewisham called DUCK CC (Dads Uniting Cycling Kids Cycling Club). The aim of the group is to create more active children and families in Lewisham through cycling. The dads arrange monthly Dads rides and also monthly Family rides. The showings run on the first Saturday of the month from 11.30am to 1.30pm so the next showing is on Saturday September 3rd from 11.30am.




